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So, they exclusively used Greek and Latin scientific naming. Most of them are pseudo-Greek by the way like "thalarctus" and pseudo-Latin like "transistor". "Thalarctus" technically pseudo-comes from "thalassa" (sea)+"arktos" (bear), but "thala-" makes no actual sense as a suffix.
